SENATE LEGISLATION

SB-10SB-2431

1 **SB-10SB-2431: Candidate Seminar**

2 Whereas: The Student Government of the University of North Florida was established to
3 represent student concerns in all University wide matters; and

4 Whereas: The Student Senate is the legislative body of the University of North Florida's
5 Student Government given the responsibility of carrying out such legislative acts that
6 are necessary and proper for the Student Body of the University of North Florida;
7 and

8 Whereas: The Elections Code is in need of revision due to the necessity of providing extensive
9 knowledge to Candidates;

10 Whereas: The following revisions are being made to Title VI;

Chapter 603: Candidacy

12 603.1 Qualifying for Candidacy

13 D. Attend mandatory Candidate Seminars which shall be held on three (3)
14 separate dates prescribed by the Elections Supervisor. All candidates must
15 attend all three (3) scheduled seminars or meet with the Election Supervisor to
16 qualify for candidacy. All information discussed in seminars shall be previously
17 approved by the E&A committee. All additional questions answered will be
18 shared via public notice and email.

20 **Therefore: Let it be enacted, by the University of North Florida Student Government that**
21 **the proposed revisions to Title VI be made effective January 1st, 2011.**
