SENATE LEGISLATION

SB-10F-2472

1 *SB-10F-2472 : The Election Protection Act*

2 Whereas: The Student Government of the University of North Florida was established to represent student
3 concerns in all University wide matters; and

4 Whereas: The Student Senate is the legislative body of the University of North Florida's Student Government
5 given the responsibility of carrying out such legislative acts that are necessary and proper for the
6 Student Body of the University of North Florida; and

7 Whereas: Legislation dealing with necessary and proper statutory revisions shall be considered by Student
8 Senate; and

9 Whereas: Title VI is in need of revision. Currently, Title VI permits the Elections Commissioner, the Elections
10 Supervisor and the Attorney General to view election results before the election is completed. Thus,
11 in order to prevent any potential leaks from occurring, it is best to seal the results from view until the
12 completion of the election.

13 Therefore; The following revisions are being made to Title VI;

TITLE VI: THE ELECTION CODE

Chapter 611: Assuming Office

611.1 Announcement of Election Results

19 ~~B. Election results must be sealed from view until official publication. No person, except the~~
20 ~~Elections Supervisor, the Chairperson of the Elections Commission, and Attorney General~~
21 ~~may view the results until publication. No official election results can be posted until~~
22 ~~complaints or charges calling to invalidate the election have been resolved by Senate.~~
23 Election results must be sealed from view until unofficial publication. The Elections
24 Supervisor, the Elections Commissioner, and the Attorney General may view the results
25 after the polls close on the final day of the election. Official Election results can be neither
26 posted nor disclosed to any other parties until complaints or charges calling to invalidate the
27 election have been resolved by Senate.

29 Furthermore: Let it be enacted, by the University of North Florida Student Government that the
30 proposed revisions to Title VI be made effective immediately.
