SB-10F-2474 : Club Funding

2 Whereas: The Student Government of the University of North Florida was established to
3 represent student concerns in all University wide matters; and

4 Whereas: The Student Senate is the legislative body of the University of North Florida's
5 Student Government given the responsibility of carrying out such legislative acts that
6 are necessary and proper for the Student Body of the University of North Florida;
7 and

8 Whereas: Legislation dealing with necessary and proper statutory revisions shall be considered
9 by the student senate; and whereas Article II Section VA Meeting of the Senate;

10 Whereas: Chapter 1105 of Title XI deals with Club Alliance;

11 Whereas: Club Funding process is in need of a minor revision;

12 Whereas: The following revisions will be made to Title XI: Chapter 1105.6;

13 1105.6 Club Funding Process

14 A. The Director of Club Alliance shall establish the Club Alliance Funding Board by
15 September 1, which shall consist of no less than eight (8) members, including the CA
16 Director acting as chair, the CA Assistant Director acting as vice-chair, the Senate
17 President, Budget & Allocations Chairman, Student Government Treasurer, a
18 member of the Student Senate appointed by the Senate President and two club
19 members at-large chosen by the CA leadership. The Club Accountant and ~~Associate~~
20 ~~Director of Student Life~~ Assistant Director of Student Government shall be non-
21 voting, ex-officio members of the Funding Board. The Funding Board Chair shall
22 only vote in the case of a tie.

23 B. The Club Funding Board will meet bi-weekly or as deemed necessary by the chair.

24 C. According to University policy, registration expires July 1 for all clubs. Returning
25 RSOs that renew University recognition for the new school year shall be
26 automatically allocated an equal lump-sum budget of at least \$225 for that fiscal year,
27 with the amount to be determined by the previous year's funding board. Clubs must
28 be in existence a minimum of one (1) semester to be eligible for funding, and one (1)
29 year to be eligible to special request additional funding either through the Club

Alliance Funding Board, a Special Request, or Conference Travel though the Student Government Senate.

D. Qualifying RSO's desiring funds in excess of the annual lump-sum budget may submit a request to the of the funding board for a supplementary allocation of up to \$200. Such requests can be made as many times as needed throughout the year, once per fall and spring terms.
