# SENATE LEGISLATION SB-11F-2551

1		SB-11F-2551: Legislative Cabinet Election Revisions
2 3	Whereas:	The Student Government of the University of North Florida was established to represent student concerns in all University wide matters; and
4 5 6	Whereas:	The Senate is the legislative body of the University of North Florida's Student Government given the responsibility of carrying out such legislative acts that are necessary and proper for the Student Body of the University of North Florida; and
7 8	Whereas:	Legislation dealing with necessary and proper statutory revisions shall be considered by Student Senate; and
9	Whereas:	Title IV is in need of revision.
10 11	Whereas:	Currently, The Senate Policies and Procedures dictate the time for Legislative Cabinet elections. However, in the interest of preserving statutes and simplifying P&P's, the time for Legislative Cabinet elections needs to be placed in statute; and
13	Therefore;	the following revisions are being made to Title IV;
14	TITLE I	THE LEGISLATIVE BRANCH
15 16 17 18 19 20 21 22 23 24 25 26 27 28 29 30 31 32		A. There shall be a Senate President who shall be elected by majority vote of the Student Senate and who shall be selected from within the Student Senate. The Senate President shall be the Chief Legislative Officer of Student Government and shall perform duties as provided by Senate Policies and Procedures. The Senate President shall enforce all rules, policies and procedures of the Student Senate. The term of this position shall be from the beginning of the Summer-Session until the end of the following Spring Session.  B. There shall be a Student Senate President Pro-Tempore who shall be elected by a majority vote of the Student Senate and who shall be selected from within the Student Senate. The Senate President Pro-Tempore shall assist the Senate President and perform duties as provided by Senate Policies and Procedures. The term of this position shall be from the

1 SB-11F-2551: Legislative Cabinet Election Revisions 2 beginning of the Summer Session-until the end of the following Spring 3 4 5 6 7 8 Session. C. There shall be a Secretary of the Student Senate who shall be appointed by the Senate President and who shall serve at his/her discretion. The Secretary of the Student Senate shall perform duties as provided by Senate Policies and Procedures and as directed by the Senate President. 9 10 D. There shall be a Parliamentarian who shall be elected by majority vote of 11 the Senate shall be selected from within the Student Senate. The 12 Parliamentarian shall, upon request, give advice on Parliamentary 13 procedure. 14 15 E. There shall be a Sergeant-at-Arms, who shall be appointed by the Senate President, subject to confirmation by the Student-Senate. The Sergeant-at-Arms shall attend the Student Senate during its meetings and maintain 18 order under the discretion of the Senate President or Presiding Officer. The 19 Sergeant-at-Arms shall enforce strictly the rules relating to the privileges of 20 the chamber. 21 22 F. Standing committee Chairs shall be elected by a majority vote of the 23 Student Senate. Elections shall occur upon the convening of a new Senate 24 after the Fall and Spring elections for both semi-annual and yearlong 25 positions, as stated in Senate Policies and Procedures. 26 27 Legislative Cabinet elections shall occur upon the convening of the new 28 Senate in the spring semester. All positions will be elected during the 29 meeting that the newly elected Senators are sworn in. The Elections and 30 Appointments Committee Chair shall be elected to a semester term at the 31 end of both fall and spring semesters. 32 33 F.
