SB-12S-2575 : The Quick Fix Act of Spring 2012

4 Whereas: The Student Government of the University of North Florida was established to represent
5 student concerns in all University wide matters; and
- 6 Whereas: The Student Senate is the legislative body of the University of North Florida's Student
7 Government given the responsibility of carrying out such legislative acts that are necessary
8 and proper for the Student Body of the University of North Florida; and
- 9 Whereas: Legislation dealing with necessary and proper statutory revisions shall be considered by
10 Student Senate; and
- 11 Whereas: Title VI is in need of a quick fix from the previous revision
- 12 Therefore; the following revisions are being made to Title VI;

TITLE VI: THE ELECTION CODE
