SENATE LEGISLATION SB-12S-2575

SB-12S-2575 : The Quick Fix Act of Spring 2012

- 4Whereas:The Student Government of the University of North Florida was established to represent5student concerns in all University wide matters; and
- 6Whereas:The Student Senate is the legislative body of the University of North Florida's Student7Government given the responsibility of carrying out such legislative acts that are necessary8and proper for the Student Body of the University of North Florida; and
- 9 Whereas: Legislation dealing with necessary and proper statutory revisions shall be considered by Student Senate; and
- 11 Whereas: Title VI is in need of a quick fix from the previous revision
- 12 Therefore; the following revisions are being made to Title VI;
