1		CA-06S-1982: Clarification of Voter Eligibility
2 3	Whereas:	The Student Government of the University of North Florida was established to represent student concerns in all University wide matters, and;
4 5 6 7	Whereas:	The Student Senate is the legislative body of the University of North Florida's Student Government, given the responsibility of carrying out such legislative acts that are necessary and proper for the Student Body of the University of North Florida;
8 9	Whereas:	Legislation dealing with necessary and proper statutory revisions shall be considered by the Student Senate;
10 11	Whereas:	The Constitution and Statutes Committee is responsible for making revisions to the Student Government Constitution and Statutes as needed, and;
(	Whereas:	The Constitution is in need of revision;
13 14 15	Whereas:	The University of North Florida's Student Government Constitution requires clarification to ensure no law is enacted which may unfairly hinder a student's right to vote;
16 17	Therefore:	Let it be enacted, that a Constitutional Referendum be placed on the ballot for the Spring 2006 General Election by the Elections Supervisor, and;
18 19	Further:	Let it be further enacted, that the Referendum to be placed before the student body be submitted as follow:
20 21		Article V: Elections Section 1: Eligible Voters
22 23 24		G. Student Government will make enact no law to this Section which adds any additional eligibility criteria to this Section or law which unfairly hinders a registered student's right to vote.
