## SENATE LEGISLATION

### CA-06S-1983

1		CA-06S-1983: Installation of Elected Officers
2 3	Whereas:	The Student Government of the University of North Florida was established to represent student concerns in all University wide matters, and;
4 5 6	Whereas:	The Student Senate is the legislative body of the University of North Florida's Student Government, given the responsibility of carrying out such legislative acts that are necessary and proper for the Student Body of the University of North Florida;
7 8	Whereas:	Legislation dealing with necessary and proper statutory revisions shall be considered by the Student Senate;
9 10	Whereas:	The Constitution and Statutes Committee is responsible for making revisions to the Student Government Constitution and Statutes as needed, and;
11	Whereas:	The Constitution is in need of revision;
13 14	Whereas:	The University of North Florida's Student Government Constitution is currently lacking proper language outlining the process in which elected officials are installed once any claims for invalidation have been dealt with;
15 16	Therefore:	Let it be enacted, that a Constitutional Referendum be placed on the ballot for the Fall 2006 General Election by the Elections Supervisor, and;
17 18	Further:	Let it be further enacted, that the Referendum to be placed before the student body be submitted as follow:
19 20		Article V: Elections Section 6 7: Installation
21 22 23 24 25		All Student Government's duly elected officers shall immediately take office at the time of their installation. In the absence of a legitimate challenge to the validity of the entire General, Inter-College, or Special Election, newly elected officials shall be installed within five (5) business days, beginning on the last business day of the General, Inter-College, or Special Elections, respectively.
26 27 28 29		The installation process shall begin at the next senate meeting following the validation of any General, Inter-College or Special Elections results, as in accordance with Section 6 of this Article. Upon installation, elected officials shall assume all abilities and responsibilities of their respective office.
