1 *SB-06S-1969 : Title VI – Introduction and Purpose*

2 Whereas: The Student Government of the University of North Florida was established to
3 represent student concerns in all University wide matters, and;

4 Whereas: The Student Senate is the legislative body of the University of North Florida’s
5 Student Government, given the responsibility of carrying out such legislative acts
6 that are necessary and proper for the Student Body of the University of North
7 Florida;

8 Whereas: Legislation dealing with necessary and proper statutory revisions shall be
9 considered by the Student Senate;

10 Whereas: Title VI is need of revision;

11 Whereas: Title VI currently does not contain any information or explanation introducing the
12 purpose of: Title VI, the creation of the Elections, Selections & Appointments
13 Committee (ESAC), the role of the Elections Commission (EC), and that
14 revisions made to Title VI shall be heard by Elections, Selections &
15 Appointments Committee;

16 Whereas: The following section will be added to Title VI:

24 600.1 Introduction

26 A. Student Government shall make every effort to comply and follow
27 standards set forth in Florida Law governing elections. This shall
28 include, but not be limited to: the review of the rules governing
29 standards and certification of voting systems, the adoption of rules to
30 achieve and maintain the maximum degree of correctness,
31 impartiality, and efficiency of the procedures of voting, including
write-in voting, and of counting, tabulating, and recording votes by
voting systems used in Student Government elections; the security

standards for voting systems, and the authorization and approval of the registration process for voter identification.

B. The standing committee of the UNF Student Senate assigned the responsibility for oversight, review, and periodic update of the policies expressed in the Election Code shall be known as the Elections, Selections & Appointments Committee (ESAC).

C. The ad-hoc committee of the UNF Student Senate assigned the responsibility for oversight, review, and enforcement of the Elections Statute during an election cycle shall be known as the Elections Commission (EC).

D. Amendments to the Election Code are subject to the normal legislative process and also require a majority approval from ESAC.

The following words and phrases, when used in this Title, shall be defined as the following:

Therefore: Let it be enacted, by the University of North Florida Student Senate that these proposed revisions are made into Title VI of the Student Government Statutes as soon as possible to ensure compliance.
