1		SB-06SA-2031: Title VI – The Voter Registry					
2	Whereas:	The Student Government of the University of North Florida was established to represent student concerns in all University wide matters, and;					
4 5 6	Whereas:	The Student Senate is the legislative body of the University of North Florida's Student Government, given the responsibility of carrying out such legislative acts that are necessary and proper for the Student Body of the University of North Florida;					
7 8	Whereas:	Legislation dealing with necessary and proper statutory revisions shall be considered by the Student Senate;					
9	Whereas:	The following revisions will be made to Title VI:					
10 11 13	Whereas:	It is in the best interest of Student Government's accountability to implement a Voter Registry, which will include the signatures of each student who votes in a given election. The Voter registry, in addition to the number of ballots and the number of students flagged within the registrar, shall also serve as a means of comparing voter counts in triplicate;					
14 15 16 17 18 19 20		The Voter Registry The Elections Supervisor may create a Voter Registry to serve as a means of further determining the actual number of voters during a given election. This is recommended for an election for which the ballots will be hand counted. A. Preparing the Voter Registry and Record Sheets					
21 22 23 24 25 26		 The Voter Registry shall be prepared by the Elections Supervisor at least two (2) business days before the first day of elections. The Voter Registry shall consist of a sufficient number of blank Record Sheets that are to be fashioned together in a binder.

A Record Sheet shall be incremented with a standard number of potential student entries per page, shall indicate and provide adequate space for a voter to print his/her name, signature and partial N number. The Record Sheet shall also provide a space, preferably at the bottom, for the signatures of both the Elections Supervisor and the SG Advisor.					
35 36		4. Each blank Record Sheet must be initialed by both the Elections Supervisor and the SG Advisor before the first day of elections.					
37		5. For convenience, a polling station may have multiple Voter Registries.
