Here's how...

Verifying Provider Data

Computers help investigators at BCBSF screen providers by verifying their addresses, phone numbers, occupational licenses, and affiliations with medical

facilities. This data is checked against actual physical addresses to flag potentially fraudulent information.





Identifying Fraud Networks

Computerassisted link analysis helps BCBSF's

investigators identify fraudulent networks of providers. Fraudulent networks can include billing services, business owners, physicians, and others who assist each other in committing scams, often forming elaborate and complex webs of fictitious names & business fronts.

Examining Utilization Patterns

BCBSF's investigators are using computers to

examine providers' and beneficiaries' utilization


patterns.
By comparing this information to data from regions with similar

demographics, the Medicare Fraud Branch can more accurately identify which providers to investigate.

Using Artificial Intelligence

Electronic fraud detection uses "expert knowledge", taken from real world investigative experience, and integrates this with statistical and geographical models. With the enhanced analytical power of artificial intelligence, the systems alert BCBSF to unusual provider behavior previously undiscovered.
