# SENATE LEGISLATION

## SR-13S-2665B

1 *SR-13S-2665B: Scholarship Reconstruction Act*

2 Whereas: The Student Government of the University of North Florida was established to  
3 represent student concerns in all University wide matters; and

4 Whereas: The Student Senate is the legislative body of the University of North Florida's  
5 Student Government given the responsibility of carrying out such legislative acts that  
6 are necessary and proper for the Student Body of the University of North Florida;  
7 and

8 Whereas: Legislation dealing with necessary and proper statutory revisions shall be considered  
9 by Student Senate; and

10 Whereas: The Senate Policies and Procedures are in need of revision. The lack of criteria and  
11 structure of the senatorial scholarship must be addressed.

Furthermore: The following revisions are being proposed to the Senate Policies and Procedures;

31 **1. Each elected Senator shall be eligible for a Student Government**  
32 **Senate scholarship. A scholarship will be awarded upon completion**  
33 **of a full term and fulfillment of the workshop and participatory**  
34 **requirements, and the policies set forth by the SG Scholarship**
