SB-13SA-2693: Club Funding Revisions Act

2 Whereas: The Student Government of the University of North Florida was established to represent student
3 concerns in all University wide matters, and;

4

5 Whereas: Student Government is responsible for revising and updating the bylaws from time to time and;

7 Whereas: The Senate is the appropriate body charged with approving such revisions, and;

8

9 Whereas: Legislation dealing with necessary and proper statutory revisions shall be considered by Student
10 Senate;

11

12 Whereas: Title XI is in need of revision to better accommodate registered student organizations' requests for
13 additional funding;

15 Furthermore: The Following revisions to Title XI are being proposed.

TITLE XI: EXECUTIVE AGENCY STATUTE

1104.2 Internal Organization and Structure

21 In order to be considered a Student Government recognized organization a Registered
22 Student Organization (RSO) form must be submitted to CA. Membership is mandatory and
23 RSOs may join at any time. CA shall maintain an up to date Policies and Procedure manual
24 and Club Alliance RSO Handbook subject to approval by the President.

1104.3 Director

A. Powers and Duties of the Director

30 The Director is a paid position working to provide support services to student clubs.
31 Additional duties include:

1. Maintaining the Club Alliance office.

1104.4 Assistant Director

A. Powers and Duties of the Assistant Director:

47 The Assistant Director is a paid position working to provide support services to
48 student clubs. Additional duties include:

- 50 1. Aiding the Director in any task he/she may need assistance.

- 52 2. Maintaining the Club Alliance office in the absence of the Director.
- 53
- 54 3. Conducting ~~bi-weekly~~ monthly meetings; unless otherwise deemed
55 necessary.

1104.7 Club Funding Process

- 59 A. The Director of Club Alliance shall establish the Club Funding Board by
60 September 1, which shall consist of ~~four~~ five ~~six~~ (54 6) ~~no less than eight~~ (8)
61 members; including the Club Alliance Director, Club Alliance Assistant
62 Director, Club Alliance Student Coordinator selected by the Director, acting
63 as chair, the CA Assistant Director acting as vice chair, the Senate President
64 or his or her designee, Budget & Allocations Chairman, Treasurer, and a
65 Senator appointed by the President. a member of the Senate appointed by
66 the Senate President and two club members at large chosen by the CA
67 leadership. and the Club Accountant, and Assistant Director of Student
68 Government shall be non-voting, ex-officio members of the Funding Board.
69 The Club Funding Board Chair shall only vote in the case of a tie.

72 **Therefore:** Let it be enacted, by the University of North Florida Student Government, that the
73 following changes be made effective upon passage.
