## SENATE LEGISLATION JR-13F-2714

1	JR-13F-2	714: Endorsement of Florida Board of Governors Inclusion of CITF Bonding in 2013-14 LBR
2 3 4 5	Whereas:	The Student Government of the University of North Florida was established to create a representative government through which the individual student voice can be heard, and which students can actively participate in this University by promoting cooperation among the student body, faculty, and administration, and;
6 7	Whereas:	The Student Government of the University of North Florida was established to represent student concerns in all university wide matters; and
8 9 10	Whereas:	Student Government believes activities, services and facilities that offer extracurricular programming are vital components to a university's campus and overall student success, and;
11 12 13 14	Whereas:	During this Week of Welcome's Student Government Convention, students were asked "Do non-academic buildings (Student Union, Wellness Complex, etc.) contribute to the quality of your overall educational experience," and 93.6% of respondents said "yes," and;
15 16 17	Whereas:	Construction of such facilities has historically been driven in large part by funding allocations from the leverage of the Capital Improvement Trust Fund (CITF) Fee, and;
18 19 20 21	Whereas:	The Florida Board of Governors' (BOG) 2013-14 Legislative Budget Request (LBR) includes a request that the state government allow the bonding of the CITF fee, yielding an additional \$120 million of facilities funding for our university system next year;
22 23 24	Therefore:	Let it be resolved that the Student Government of the University of North Florida commends the BOG for leading on this issue and including a request for bonding into the board's LBR, and;

Furthermore: Let this resolution be forwarded to each member of the Florida Board of Governors

and State University System Interim Chancellor Dr. Jan Ignash.
