

Application to Serve Employee Grant Review Team 2001 At Blue Cross and Blue Shield of Florida, we take great pride in helping our members lead healthy, confident lives. We also believe strongly in giving back to our communities. This commitment to caring solutions for Floridians is just one reason why Blue Cross and Blue Shield of Florida has created a new philanthropic foundation, The Blue Foundation for a Healthy Florida, Inc.

The Blue Foundation for a Healthy Florida is a separate entity that will help us reach beyond our day-to-day mission and focus solely on making contributions to charitable organizations that promote better health and education in Florida.

The mission of The Blue Foundation was designed to be broad enough to have a significant impact on the many different health care challenges in Florida. The Blue Foundation will award charitable grants to 501(c)(3) programs and organizations that positively impact the health and well-being of uninsured and underserved Floridians. The foundation also will support health care education, awareness and training programs and workforce preparation initiatives that address the health care challenges facing Florida today.

The foundation will accomplish this mission through a combination of grants and support for demonstration projects, research and policy initiatives, rather than directly financing the provision of health care services. The Blue Foundation is accepting its first grant proposals in the Summer of 2001, with the first awards being announced in October. After this initial cycle, grants will be awarded twice a year in April and October.

At BCBSF, employees are our number-one asset. Through the Blue Community Champions program and your volunteer efforts, you know about the community's needs and the organizations that are meeting those needs. We are asking you to consider applying for a position on the employee team that reviews the grant applications and makes funding recommendations to the foundation board of directors.

The BCBSF Employee Grant Review Team and foundation staff will review all applications received by the deadline for each grant cycle. This team will make recommendations to The Blue Foundation board of directors grant committee. The committee will make the final funding recommendations to The Blue Foundation board of directors, who will choose the final grant recipients.

There is an application and selection process for the Employee Grant Review Team. The team will consist of 12 employees and four alternates from across the company. Criteria will include current position, grade level, length of service with BCBSF, community involvement, office location, performance rating, special skills and management approval. The foundation board of directors and foundation staff will choose the team members based on the criteria, geographic location and cultural diversity.

Involving a diverse group of employees from across the state will assure that the foundation is funding organizations with the greatest need and a strong connection to the foundation's mission.

Participation on the Employee Grant Review Team is voluntary and must be approved by the employee's manager. Employees will be expected to attend meetings in Jacksonville, or other locations as determined by foundation staff and board of directors. Frequency of meetings will be determined by the number of grant applications received, but the time commitment for service on the team is expected to be approximately 60 hours a year. The grant review team members may also be asked to conduct on-site visits to potential grantees for further information and verification of request. Costs for travel will be reimbursed by The Blue Foundation for a Healthy Florida while conducting business for the foundation.

The BCBSF Employee Grant Review Team members will serve alternating terms. Alternating terms will allow continuity on the teams while also providing other employees the opportunity to serve. Team alternates will fill in for other team members when needed and would be considered first when choosing new team members. The team will be broken down as follows:

Four team members – one year's service Four team members – 18 months' service Four team members – two years' service

Employees will be considered BCBSF employees at all times while conducting business for the foundation. BCBSF policies and procedures will apply to the activities of the Employee Grant Review Team and its members. An employee must resign from the grant review team if the employee leaves the company for any reason, or an annual performance appraisal is below meets expectations.

Blue Community Champions will consider Employee Grant Review Team applicants who are not selected, for its Ambassador program. Ambassadors serve in an advisory capacity, act as champions for BCBSF's volunteer projects, help steer the direction and focus of the program, and participate in successful implementation of volunteer projects. We will choose the team members in September and notify you and your manager if chosen.
