SENATE LEGISLATION

SB-14S-2756

1 *SB-14S-2756: Executive Branch – TurboVote*

2 Whereas: The Student Government of the University of North Florida was established to represent
3 student concerns in all University wide matters, and;

4 Whereas: The Budget & Allocations Committee is a standing committee of the Student Government
5 Senate, responsible for funding only those entities that comply with the Student Government
6 mission, which is to represent student concerns in all university wide matters while
7 developing and promoting programs and activities of practical value and interest to students,
8 and;

9 Whereas: This purchase or activity reflects the genuine students interest and enhances the social,
10 cultural, and recreational interests of the University of North Florida students and;

11 Whereas: Executive Branch is requesting funding for TurboVote, a service provided by a non-partisan
12 501(c)(3) non-profit organization. The service provides online services to help people vote in
13 elections. In doing so, TurboVote facilitates voter registration and voting, by helping people
14 get registered, helping them change their address or party affiliation, sending absentee
15 ballots, and sending out reminders for when elections occur. These services allow schools to
16 build civic engagement within their student body and have been utilized in universities across
17 the country.

18 Whereas: Executive Branch is requesting the following:

19	Base Fee		= \$ 1,000.00
20	Mailing Fee	\$1.17 x 660	= \$ 772.20
