1		<b>CR-14SB-2776:</b> Refinement within the Judicial Branch
2 3	Whereas:	The Student Government of the University of North Florida was established to represent student concerns in all University wide matters, and;
4 5 6	Whereas:	The Senate is the legislative body of the University of North Florida's Student Government given the responsibility of carrying out such legislative acts that are necessary and proper for the Student Body of the University of North Florida; and;
7 8	Whereas:	Legislation dealing with necessary and proper statutory revisions to the system of statutes shall be considered by the Senate; and
9 10 11	Therefore:	The following necessary and proper revision to the Student Government Constitution is being proposed with the intention to refine the Student Body Constitution so that the Judicial Branch can run more efficiently;
12	Therefore:	The following revisions are being made to Article:
13		Article IV: THE JUDICIARY
14	Section 1: Judicial Powers	
15 16		The Judicial Power of Student Government shall be vested in the <u>Supreme Court</u> Judicial Council.
17	Section 2: Composition of the Judicial CouncilSupreme Court	
18 19	A. Justice	The <u>Supreme CourtJudicial Council</u> shall be composed of <u>seven (7)nine (9)</u> total es.
20 21	В.	A Chief Justice shall be elected annually from within the Council to serve as the presiding officer and shall serve a one (1) year term.
22 23 24	C.	An <u>Associate Deputy</u> Chief Justice shall be appointed annually from within the Judicial Council by the Chief Justice and shall assume the duties of the Chief Justice in the event of his/her absence.
25 26	D.	Other officers that the Council deems necessary shall be chosen according to Judicial Rules and Procedures.

2 3 4	A.	Terms: Upon installation, justices may serve <u>a maximum of six (6) years</u> as long as they remain qualified. Acting Justices may also resign their position at any time for any reason.	
5 6	В.	Qualifications: Justices must be A & S fee paying students, enrolled in at least one (1) class during both the fall and spring semester, and maintain a 2.25 GPA or higher.

8 9 10 11	А.	Procedure: When there is a vacancy on the Judicial Council, the President shall forward a Judicial Nominee to Senate for majority confirmation. Upon majority confirmation from Senate, the Judicial Nominee shall immediately be installed as an acting Justice.

14 15 16	A.	Powers: The <u>Judicial CouncilSupreme Court</u> shall have the power of Judicial Review over all Executive and Legislative Acts. This power shall include and be limited as prescribed by law.	
17 18 19 20	l	1. The <u>Supreme Court Judicial Council</u> must negate and remove existing Student Government Statute, Appropriation, Law, Joint Resolution, Executive Order, and/or Senatorial policy when in conflicts with any provisions of the Student Government Constitution.

The <u>Supreme Court Judicial Council</u> -must negate and remove existing Student Government Statute, Appropriation, Law, Joint Resolution, Executive Order, and/or Senatorial policy when in conflicts with any Federal law, State law, Local law or ordinance. Prior to any judgment that negates or removes existing Student Government Statute, Appropriation, Law, Joint Resolution, Executive Order, and/or Senatorial policy that is being challenged on the grounds that it violates Federal law, State law, Local law or ordnance, or University regulation, the <u>Supreme Court Judicial Council-must</u> <u>may</u> consult with the University of North Florida's General Counsel.

The <u>Supreme Court Judicial Council</u> -may issue a temporary stay against the application of a Student Government Statute, Appropriation, Law, Joint Resolution, Executive Order, and/or Senatorial policy in time sensitive matters not to exceed ten (10) business days, in order to provide ample time

2 3		for a judicial hearing and decision. The <u>Supreme Court Judicial Council</u> shall not issue more than two (2) stays for any one complaint or issue.

The <u>Supreme Court Judicial Council</u> shall serve as the final deciding body for all disputes between Student Government student employees, members, and/or elected officials which involve Student Government law. Judicial relief in such cases shall be prescribed by law but must always be comparable to the Judicial power exercised by courts in the United States Federal Court System.
11 12 13 14 15	B.	General Restrictions: The aforementioned power of Judicial Review outlined in Section 5 of this Article cannot be enacted unless an A & S fee paying student files a written complaint. Furthermore, the complainant cannot be a member of the Judicial Council and any judgment rendered must be within the purview of the complaint.
16 17 18	C.	Constitutional Restriction: <u>Supreme Court The Judicial Council may</u> not change, amend, negate, or remove any provision of the Student Government Constitution at any time for any reason.
19	Sectio	n 6: Administration: Practice and Procedure
20 21	A.	Quorum for a Student Government <u>Supreme Court Judicial Council</u> -hearing shall be set at fifty percent (50%) plus one (1) of the current membership.
22 23 24	B.	The Chief Justice of the <u>Supreme Court Judicial Council</u> shall serve as the chief administrative officer of the judiciary and shall be vested with, and shall exercise, in accordance with rules adopted by the court, the authority to:

9 10 11 12 13	C. The <u>Supreme Court Judicial Council</u> -shall establish its own meeting times, rules, and procedures. Rules and procedures of the <u>Supreme Court Judicial Council</u> -may be negated and removed through a bill requiring a two-thirds vote of Senate and Presidential signature approval. If the President does not approve, the Senate may override his veto by three-fourths (3/4) vote.

15	D. The <u>Supreme Court Judicial Council</u> -shall conduct open Hearings for all cases.

17 18 19 20	Furthermore: Let it be enacted, by the University of North Florida Student Government that the proposed revisions to the Constitution be forwarded to the Student Body during the Fall 2014 General elections for evaluation to be made effective upon validation of the election.
