1 ***JR-14F-2801: Parking Improvement Fall 2014 Resolution***

2 Whereas: The Student Government of the University of North Florida was established to represent  
3 student concerns in all University-wide matters, and;

4 Whereas: Student Government has fielded an unusually high volume of complaints this fall semester,  
5 and has upon further investigation, discovered the following concerning parking issues on  
6 campus:

7 Whereas: The University has, as of September 23<sup>rd</sup>, 2014, oversold the established 14-15 "Blue"  
8 parking permit ratio of 2.3:1 passes per space by 457 passes, further resulting in a ratio of  
9 2.5:1.

10 Therefore: As the organization entrusted with "the representation of concerns for student morale,  
11 welfare, responsibility, and integrity" in all University-wide matters per Article I§3.D of the  
12 Student Government Constitution, we the students hereby request the following resolution to  
13 be sought by the University:

14 Whereas: The following request was affirmed by the Parking Advisory Council and forwarded on to  
15 various University constituents on September 26<sup>th</sup>, 2014, and;

16 Therefore: We request that all purchasers of "Blue" parking permits, in light of the aforementioned  
17 circumstances, be given the ability to exchange their "Blue" parking permits for a "Grey"  
18 permit and be given a refund for the variance in the permit prices.

19 Furthermore: An adoption of such a policy would allow for students who feel they are not receiving the  
20 benefit of a "Blue" permit to be more satisfied with their daily parking, and in so doing, will  
21 improve the parking situation of those who have retained a "Blue" parking permit.

22 **Therefore: Let this resolution be forwarded to President John Delaney, Vice President Shari**  
23 **Shuman, Vice President Mauricio Gonzalez, George Androuin, and Neal Fisher.**
