SENATE LEGISLATION

SB-08F-2252

1 **SB-08F-2252 :Definition of "Incumbent"**

2 Whereas: The Student Government of the University of North Florida was established to represent student
3 concerns in all University wide matters, and;

4 Whereas: Under Title VI, 600.2-Definitions, it states that "The following words and phrases, when used in this
5 title, shall be defined as the following" and shall be held as binding in this code;

6 Whereas: Presidential/Vice-Presidential incumbents, in which both individuals are the same and running for the
7 same office, are not required to receive student endorsements;

8 Whereas: Elected Senatorial candidates, who are running as incumbents for an At-Large Seat or for the same
9 college seat, are not required to receive a student endorsement;

10 Whereas: Our election code within our Constitution and Statutes does not include a proper definition for the
11 term "Incumbent";

12 Whereas: The Current edition of Black's Law Dictionary shall be used in understanding the terms contained
13 within the Statutes:

14 **Therefore: To ensure the Student Body of the University of North Florida is accurately**
15 **represented, the following definition shall be added into Title VI: The**
16 **Election Code:**

17 600.2 Definitions

18 TT. Incumbent- One who holds and official post, or office.
