SENATE LEGISLATION JR-19F-3450

JR-19F-3450: Joint Resolution in Support of Jacksonville Climate Action Plan

1 2	Whereas:	The Student Government of the University of North Florida was established to represent student concerns in all University wide matters, and;
3 4 5	Whereas:	The Senate is the legislative body of the University of North Florida's Student Government given the responsibility of carrying out such legislative acts that are necessary and proper for the Student Body of the University of North Florida, and;
6 7	Whereas:	The Student Government of the University of North Florida has a constitutional duty to advocate for matters concerning the student body;
8 9	Whereas:	The University of North Florida's core values include "Responsibility to the Natural Environment" and "Community Engagement";
10 11	Whereas:	The University of North Florida professes a responsibility to the student body's wellbeing and safety as a basic human right;
12 13 14 15	Whereas:	The Fourth National Climate Assessment and overwhelming scientific consensus indicates that anthropogenic climate change poses serious and growing threats of heat waves, flooding, extreme weather, and disease to coastal areas in the Southeastern United States, such as Jacksonville;
16 17	Whereas:	The city of Jacksonville is the only major metropolitan area in the state of Florida that does not have a climate or sustainability action plan to combat and adapt to climate change;
18	Whereas:	The University of North Florida and its students are part of the Jacksonville community;
19 20	Whereas:	The safety and longevity of our campus depend on the safety and longevity of the City of Jacksonville;
21 22 23 24 25 26	Therefore:	Let it be known that the Student Government at the University of North Florida recognizes the need for the city of Jacksonville to develop a climate change action plan and reaffirms the requests of the letter sent to the City Council and Mayor Curry in regard this issue which was signed by Dr. Rosenblatt, Dr. Aspinwall, Dr. Gellers, Dr. Lieberman, Dr. Truelove, Dr. Jaffee, Dr. Fenner, Dr. Stalker, Dr. White, Dr. Johnson, and Ms. Hoffman from University of North Florida, Jacksonville University, and Florida State College of Jacksonville.
27 28	Furthermore:	Upon passage, let this Joint Resolution be forwarded to all 19 members of the Jacksonville City Council and Mayor Lenny Curry.
