JOINT RESOLUTION

NUMBER JR-01F-1452

1 JR-01F-1452 Recommendation for compromise on the amplified sound policy

2 Whereas: The Student Government of the University of North Florida was established to represent
3 student concerns in all University wide matters, and;

4 Whereas: It is within the power of Student Government to issue resolutions of concern on the
5 behalf of the student body of the University of North Florida, and;

6 Whereas: The Faculty Association has reviewed the existing sound policy and is recommending
7 more stringent guidelines;

8 Whereas: The Student Body President and the Senate President have been meeting with
9 administrators and faculty members in order to develop a compromise;

10 Whereas: The amplified sound policy regulates activities on the Green seven days a week limiting
11 programming opportunities for clubs and agencies;

12 Whereas: It is not the mission of Student Government to de-emphasize the importance of
13 academics, but instead to create a well-rounded student that has a diverse experience at
14 the University of North Florida;

15 Therefore: Let it be resolved that the Student Government of the University of North Florida
16 supports a limit on the number of amplified sound events on the Green and sets that
17 limit at three events each semester during the restricted times of Monday through
18 Thursday from noon to 1:30;

19 Further: Student Clubs and Student Government agencies shall have unlimited access to the
20 Green during the times that classes are not in session or have few classes in session;

21 Further: Those times for unlimited access are Monday through Thursday after 9 pm, Friday and
22 Saturday after 4 pm and all day Sunday;

23 Further: This recommendation shall be presented at the Faculty Affairs committee meeting as
24 the students' recommendation for compromise. Copies will further be distributed to
25 the involved administrators that have been meeting on this issue as well as the
26 University President, Provost and Vice President for Student Affairs.
