JR-17S-3109: Light Up the Night – Campus Safety

- 2 Whereas: The Student Government of the University of North Florida was established to represent student
3 concerns in all University wide matters;
- 4 Whereas: The University must establish a safe environment conducive to learning and academic success;
- 5 Whereas: Student Government conducted an Osprey Voice Survey on campus safety during February, 2017.
6 A total of 179 out of 408 students (43.87%) indicated that they, at some point during their time at
7 UNF, have “felt unsafe while walking through campus at night,” and;
- 8 Whereas: Out of those 179 students, a total of 167 (93.30%) indicated that they would “feel safer walking
9 through campus at night if there were more lights along the walkways,” and;
- 10 Whereas: Student Government recognizes that campus safety is a major concern that must be addressed
11 immediately by increasing the number of light sources throughout campus;
- 12 Whereas: Student Government conducted the Campus Safety Walk at 9:00 PM on February 15th, 2017,
13 which was a fact finding mission to identify the exact regions of campus that do not have sufficient
14 lighting;
- 15 Whereas: Based on this walk and the free responses from the survey, we have identified the following
16 locations as top priorities that need to be addressed: the pathway connecting Bldg. 57 and Lot 14,
17 the areas directly west and southwest of the Lazzara, the area between the UNF Softball Complex
18 and Harmon Stadium, both of the boardwalks originating at Osprey Cove, the sidewalk connecting
19 Lot 17 to Osprey Crossings Bldg. S, the sidewalk adjacent to Hidden Lake, and Peace Plaza;
- 20 Whereas: The number one priority goal of the UNF Campus Safety Advisory Council is to “open University
21 communication lines about safety and security issues on campus.”
- 22 **Therefore: Student Government calls on the UNF Campus Safety Advisory Council to address the**
23 **significant safety issue outlined above by increasing the number of light sources in all of**
24 **the aforementioned locations.**
- 25 **Furthermore: Let this Joint Resolution be forwarded to the UNF Campus Safety Advisory Council,**
26 **President John Delaney, Vice President Mauricio Gonzalez, and Associate Vice President**
27 **Everett Malcolm.**

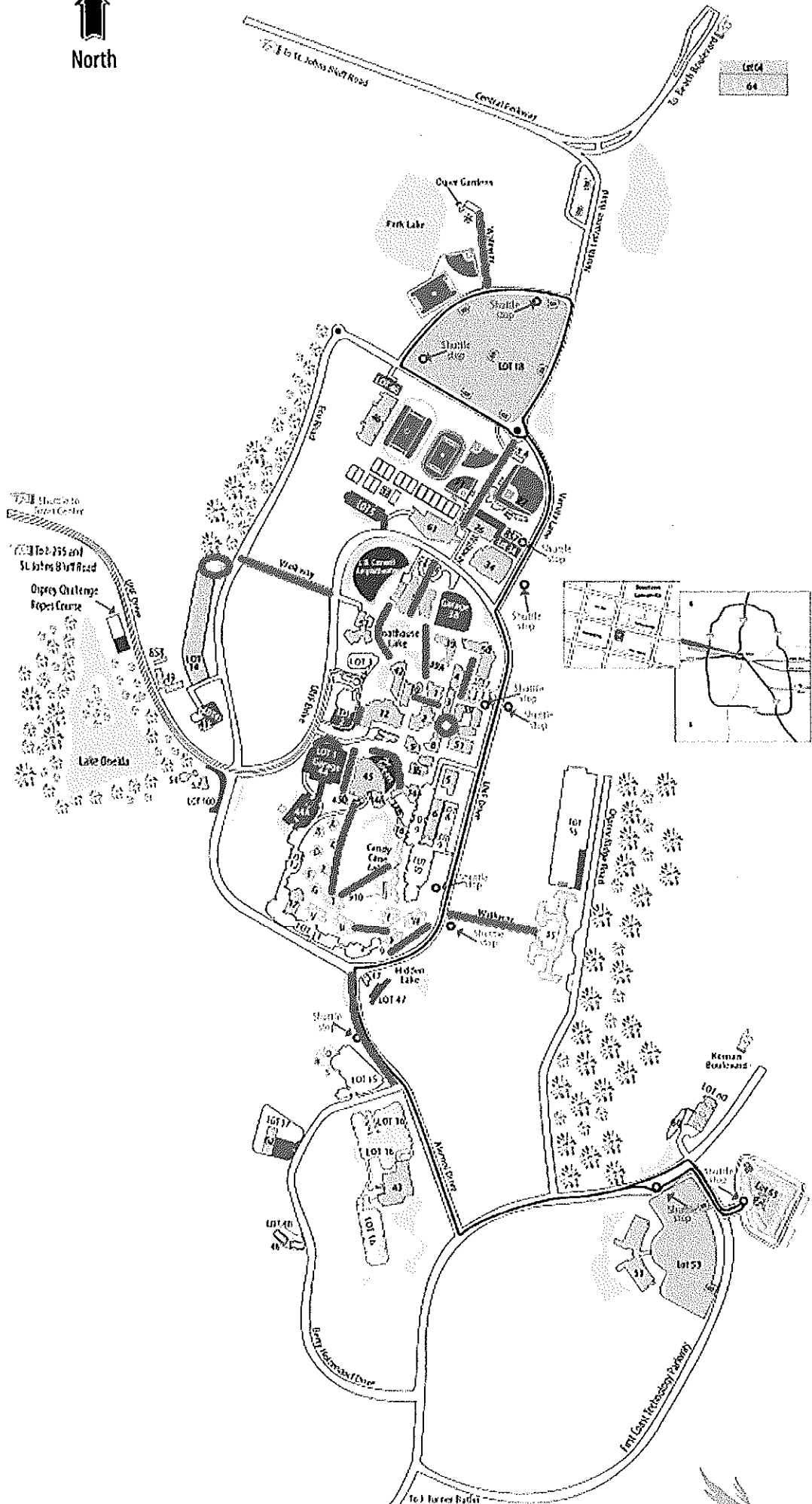
