l0 l1	Whereas:		ent Government recognizes that campus safety is a major concern that must be addressed ediately by increasing the number of light sources throughout campus;		
12 13 14	Whereas:	Student Government conducted the Campus Safety Walk at 9:00 PM on February 15th, 2017, which was a fact finding mission to identify the exact regions of campus that do not have sufficient lighting;			
15 16 17 18	Whereas:	Based on this walk and the free responses from the survey, we have identified the following locations as top priorities that need to be addressed: the pathway connecting Bldg. 57 and Lot 14, the areas directly west and southwest of the Lazzara, the area between the UNF Softball Complex and Harmon Stadium, both of the boardwalks originating at Osprey Cove, the sidewalk connecting Lot 17 to Osprey Crossings Bldg. S, the sidewalk adjacent to Hidden Lake, and Peace Plaza;			
20 21	Whereas:	The number one priority goal of the UNF Campus Safety Advisory Council is to "open University communication lines about safety and security issues on campus."
