Whereas: The Student Government of the University of North Florida was established to represent student concerns in all University wide matters, and;

Whereas: Title VIII reads in chapter 802 section 1: "The Budget and Allocations Committee (hereafter referred to as the "B&A") is one of four standing committees of the SGA Senate. It consists of nine SGA Senators, one Faculty Association Representative, and the SGA Budget and Allocation Committee Chairperson. Non-voting Ex-Officio members include the SGA President, SGA Vice President, and SGA Senior Accountant.

Therefore: Let in now read in chapter 802 section 1: "The Budget and Allocations Committee (hereafter referred to as the "B&A") is one of four standing committees of the SG Senate. It consists of nine SG Senators, the SG Budget and Allocation Committee Chairperson and a Vice-Chairperson. All voting members of the committee will be senators including the Vice-Chairperson. Non-voting Ex-Officio members include one Faculty Association Representative, the SG President, SG Vice President, and SG Senior Accountant.

- 5 behalf of the student body of the University of North Florida, and;
- 6 Whereas: Currently, the University of North Florida has no policies regulating academic
- 7 misconduct;

- 9 Affairs and the Vice President for Student Affairs to develop guidelines for this process;
- 10 Whereas: The opinion of the Student Government and the Faculty Association has been solicited to
- 11 determine the implementation of this academic misconduct policy;

- 13 supports the proposed guidelines for the academic misconduct process as attached.

SB-03S-1661B:2003-2004 Activity and Service Fee Fiscal Budget

- 2 Whereas: The Student Government of the University of North Florida was established to
- 3 represent student concerns in all University wide matters, and;
- 4 Whereas: The Budget and Allocations Committee is a standing committee of the Student
- 5 Government Senate, responsible for funding only those entities that comply with
- 6 the Student Government mission which is to represent student concerns in all
- 7 university wide matters while developing and promoting programs and activities
- 8 of practical value and interest to students, and;
- 9 Whereas: The 2003-2004 Balanced Budget, with provisionary language or riders, was
- 10 placed on display in the SG office on March 8, 2003 at 8:20 pm and;
- 11 Whereas: A Budget Workshop was completed on March 25, 2002 at 6:30 pm and;
- 12 Whereas: Title VIII states in 803.5 "Each fiscal year the B&A Committee shall approve and
- 13 display in public view a proposed budget including provisionary language and
- 14 riders at least ten business days (817.7) prior to the Senate voting. The counting
- 15 of business days shall begin the business day after the B&A approved budget is
- 16 on display in public view. During this ten business day period, a budget
- 17 presentation / workshop shall be conducted by the B&A Chairperson to explain
- 18 the B&A approved budget and the budget process", and;
- 19 **Therefore: Let it be enacted, by the University of North Florida Student Government,**
- 20 **that the proposed attached 2003-2004 Balanced A&S Fee Fiscal Budget be**
- 21 **accepted with provisionary language and riders.**

1 *JR-04F-1812: Restricting Credit Card Solicitors on Campus*

2 Whereas: The Student Government of the University of North Florida was
3 established to represent student concerns in all University wide matters;

4 Whereas: In representing student concerns, Student Government as a whole
5 believes that this concern should be addressed;

6 Whereas: Student Government strongly requests Club Alliance to regulate credit
7 card vendors that clubs allow on campus by the following measures:

8 Whereas: Require all credit card vendors to hand-out an informational flier, to be
9 approved by Student Life, concerning identity theft and credit card debt
10 prior to the distribution of any and all credit card registration forms.

11 Whereas: Credit Card vendors who are not in compliance with the regulations of
12 student government and club alliance should not be permitted on campus.

13 Therefore: May it be resolved, by the Student Government of the University of
14 North Florida, that we strongly urge Club Alliance to adhere to the
15 above recommendations.

16 Furthermore: Let this resolution be forwarded to the Club Alliance Director, General
17 Counsel, the Vice President for Student Affairs, the Dean of Student
18 Life, and the University President.

19 Furthermore: We strongly urge the Vice-President of Student Affairs, Legal Counsel,
20 and the Board of Trustees to adopt this policy with regards to Credit
21 Card vendors soliciting on campus.


