### Number SB-01F-1461

6	SB-01F-1461	Allocates money to the Resident Student Association (RSA) for 2 <sup>nd</sup> Annual Slam-Dunk Dinner
7 8	Whereas:	The Student Government of the University of North Florida was established to represent student concerns in all University wide matters, and;
9 10 11	Whereas:	The Budget and Allocations Committee is a standing committee of the Student Government Senate, which is responsible for "allocation of the Activity and Service Fees," and;
12 13	Whereas:	The Budget and Allocations Committee's goal is to grant funding to organizations that directly benefit the UNF student body, and;
14 15	Whereas:	The Resident Student Association (RSA) would like to host a basketball tournament dinner that would directly benefit the student body, and;
16 17	Whereas:	The Budget and Allocations Committee voted to allocate Resident Student Association (RSA) funds for this event;

19 20 21 22	Therefore:	Let it be enacted that, pending release of the fund balance, \$700 be allotted from the General Reserve account (907099000) to the Special Project account (907041000) for the purchase of food, paper products, and utensils for the RSA 2 <sup>nd</sup> Annual Slam-Dunk Dinner;
23 24	Further:	Let it be enacted that, if the fund balance is not released, the Bill automatically return to the Budget and Allocation Committee.
