6 ***SB-01F-1467A Transfers money from the SG Unallocated account to the SG General Reserves account***

8 Whereas: The Student Government of the University of North Florida was established to represent
9 student concerns in all University wide matters, and;

10

11 Whereas: The Budget and Allocations Committee is a standing committee of the Student
12 Government Senate, which is responsible for "allocation of the Activity and Service
13 Fees," and;

15 Whereas: Student Government is responsible for maintaining its accounts, and;

16

17 Whereas: Funds in the General Reserve Account were originally created for unexpected expenses
18 but were drawn upon for other uses;

21 Therefore: Let it be enacted that \$13,024 be allotted from SG Unallocated (907098000) to the General
22 Reserve account (907099000), bringing the General Reserve account balance to \$20,000.
