6 *SR-01F-1469 Authorizes Budget and Allocations Committee Policies and Procedures*

8 Whereas: The Student Government of the University of North Florida was established to represent
9 student concerns in all University wide matters, and;
10 Whereas: The Budget and Allocations Committee is a standing committee of the Student
11 Government Senate, which is responsible for "allocation of the Activity and Service
12 Fees," and;
13 Whereas: The Budget and Allocations Committee's goal is to grant funding to organizations that
14 directly benefit the UNF student body, and;
15 Whereas: The Budget and Allocations Committee is required by Senate Policies and Procedures (III
16 B 1 f) to "maintain a policies and procedures manual, which will serve to organize and
17 control the inner workings of the committee."
18 Whereas: The Budget and Allocations Committee has previously approved the following policies
19 and procedures.
