SR-17S-3076: Take Charge

- 1 Whereas: The Student Government of the University of North Florida was established to represent student
2 concerns in all University wide matters, and;
- 3 Whereas: The Senate is the legislative body of the University of North Florida's Student Government given
4 the responsibility of carrying out such legislative acts that are necessary and proper for the Student
5 Body of the University of North Florida; and;
- 6 Whereas: An initiative, funded by the Executive Branch in the Spring of 2016, gave the Thomas G. Carpenter
7 Library lightning and 30-pin iPhone chargers, Micro USB Chargers, and wall blocks.
- 8 Whereas: Due to the frequent usage of the lightning iPhone chargers, the Thomas G. Carpenter Library
9 consistently has a lack of lightning iPhone chargers available to students for check out.
- 10 Whereas: The Thomas G. Carpenter Library currently only has four (4) lightning iPhone chargers available to
11 students for check out.
- 12 Whereas: The Thomas G. Carpenter Library has had to replace every lightning iPhone charger at least once
13 since the purchase date.
- 14 Whereas: Employees of the Thomas G. Carpenter library have expressed concerns that students making use
15 of the available lightning iPhone chargers have taken their "dead" cords and replaced them with the
16 cords from the library.
- 17 Whereas: The current condition of the protective casing of the chargers is "dismal at best." The protective
18 casing was purchased to enhance the longevity and to aid in the organization of the phone chargers.
- 19 Whereas: Due to the poor quality of the casing, the Thomas G. Carpenter Library has stated they have been
20 forced to spend unnecessary time and money reprogramming barcodes because the cases wear out
21 so quickly. New cases require a new and unique barcode.
- 22 **Therefore:** Let it be known that the Legislative Branch of the Student Government of the University of
23 North Florida formally recognizes the Thomas G. Carpenter Library's need for additional
24 lightning iPhone chargers and protective cases.

25 Furthermore, the Legislative Branch calls upon the Executive Branch to pursue this
26 initiative within a month of the passage of this resolution, in addition to reporting back to
27 the Senate.
