JR-20S-3502: Resolution on Paid Leave for Part Time Employees During COVID-19 Break

- 1 Whereas: The Student Government of the University of North Florida was established to represent student
2 concerns in all University wide matters, and;
3
- 4 Whereas: The Senate is the legislative body of the University of North Florida’s Student Government given
5 the responsibility of carrying out such legislative acts that are necessary and proper for the Student
6 Body of the University of North Florida; and;

- 8 Whereas: According to the University of North Florida, students who travel during Spring Break 2020 are
9 advised to not return to campus and undergo a 14-day self-isolation period and the University is
10 allowing all non-essential offices to remain open, and students can work remotely when possible
11 and;

- 13 Whereas: Given the nature of many part time positions, the ability to work remotely will not be an option
14 for many employees, therefore they may have to forfeit those expected wages, which will add to
15 the anxiety and stress surrounding COVID-19 and;

- 17 Whereas: According to UNF Institutional Research 31% of UNF undergraduates are in poverty and 69%
18 of UNF undergrads work off and/or on campus and;

- 20 Whereas: Students in difficult financial situations may risk coming to work sick, potentially putting the
21 broader campus community in danger and;

- 23 Whereas: Per UNF Regulation 4.0120P 11) PRESIDENTIAL DISCRETION, “The University President,
24 may at his/her discretion, designate additional leave days with pay for administrative purposes,”
25 and;

- 27 **Therefore:** Let it be enacted that the University of North Florida Student Government urges President
28 Szymanski to invoke UNF Regulation 4.0120P 11) PRESIDENTIAL DISCRETION to grant
29 part-time employees paid leave during the COVID-19 break and all necessary breaks thereafter

- 32 **Furthermore:** Let this Joint Resolution be forwarded upon passage to the University President, Human
33 Resources, and the Administration and Finance Vice President.
