*SB-19F-3445: 2018-2019 Title VI Changes*

1 Whereas: The Student Government of the University of North Florida was established to represent  
2 student concerns in all University wide matters, and;

3 Whereas: The Senate is the legislative body of the University of North Florida's Student Government given  
4 the responsibility of carrying out such legislative acts that are necessary and proper for the  
5 Student Body of the University of North Florida, and;

6 Whereas: Legislation dealing with necessary and proper statutory revisions to the System of Statutes shall  
7 be considered by the Senate, and;

8 Whereas: It is necessary to maintain a system of checks and balances within the Student Government of  
9 the University of North Florida, and;

10 Whereas: The Election Code (Title VI) and the Elections Policies and Procedures should promote said  
11 checks and balances, and;

12 Whereas: The Election Code should reflect previous changes to how the Election Commissioner forwards  
13 any election violation;

14 Therefore: The following necessary and proper revisions to Title VI are being proposed:

TITLE VI: THE ELECTION CODE

18 **603.4 Invalidation**

19

20 A. Any Activity and Service Fee paying student may file a special Judicial Complaint with the intent  
21 to invalidate an election within two (2) business days of the conclusion of said election.

22

23 B. The Elections Commissioner and the Attorney General shall have a reasonable amount of time  
24 following the conclusion of each election to forward election violations to the Judicial Branch  
25 ~~and file, respectively, elections-related Judicial Complaints, not to exceed five (5) business days.~~

27 C. A special Judicial Complaint is subject to special provisions outlined in the Judicial Policies and  
28 Procedures.

31 Therefore: Let it be enacted that the following changes to SB-19F-3445 be made effective  
32 immediately upon passage.


