Memorandum of Understanding

To: Dr. Simon Rhodes, Provost and Vice President of Academic Affairs
From: Ally Schneider, Student Body President
Subject: Memorandum of Understanding: A&S Infusion of Student Emergency Relief Fund

This Memorandum of Understanding (MOU), is entered into by and between the Student Government of the University of North Florida and the division of Academic Affairs of the University of North Florida.

I. Mission

The mission of both parties is to support student success, and in doing so, provide aid for University of North Florida students in the midst of the COVID-19 crisis, an international event that has caused widespread financial hardship. The purpose of the Activity and Service (A&S) Fee is to benefit the student body in general, and to provide crisis aid to students reflects the intended use of the fee.

II. Objectives

This MOU seeks to establish guidelines for the disbursement of any A&S Fee money from the UNF Student Emergency Relief Fund.

III. Responsibilities of Parties

The responsibilities and requirements of each party are listed as the following:

- a. Any committee or governing body tasked with determining the allocation of funds to students must have at least one Student Government representative. This representative may be a student or a professional staff member; the Student Government representative is to be appointed by the Student Body President.
- b. Any A&S fee money that has been transferred to the UNF Student Emergency Relief Fund that is unused by December 31, 2020 must be reallocated to the originating fund.
- c. Any A&S Fee money used for student aid by the UNF Student Emergency Relief Fund must be directly related to the COVID-19 crisis.
- d. If the listed responsibilities or requirements are breached, any unused A&S Fee money will be transferred back to the originating fund upon request.

All parties agree to the stipulations with the understanding that any transfer of A&S funds is contingent upon all parties signing, as stated in any legislation authorizing the transfer.
