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SB-20F-3515: Changes to Activity & Service Fee Budget Provisionary Language Fiscal Year 2020/2021

1 Whereas: The Student Government of the University of North Florida was established to represent
2 student concerns in all University wide matters, and;

3 Whereas: The Senate is the legislative body of the University of North Florida's Student Government and
4 carries a large responsibility;

5 Whereas: Senators have been compensated for their work in the past via a Senator Service Contract;

6 Whereas: Senator Service Contracts are no longer a feasible method of compensation;

7 ~~Therefore: The money allocated for senator service contracts shall be transferred to index 204061, line item~~

9 University of North Florida Student Government Activity & Service Fee Budget Rider Student
10 Government Fiscal Year 2020/2021

11 1. The annual Student Government banquet is inclusive of Student Government's three
12 branches, two agencies, and professional staff. No branch or agency shall be permitted to have
13 a separate banquet funded by A&S Fees. Student Government shall have a single awards
14 banquet at the conclusion of the spring semester funded by a line in 402060 SG Executive.

15 2. No A&S Fee funded entity, without written permission from the SG Business Office and the
16 SG Treasurer, shall expend more than \$15 per person on food.

17 3. 402060 Student Government Executive —10% of OPS wages and Operating Expenses must
18 remain in the annual budget following the change in SG Executive Administration.

19 ~~4. 402061 Student Government Legislative—All active senators, beginning in Fall 2019, will be~~
20 ~~eligible to receive a service contract, dependent on the rules and guidelines set forth by the Senate~~
21 ~~President, and in accordance with the SG Constitution and Statutes and Title VIII. If the policies~~
22 ~~set forth by UNF Human Resources and the Senate President do not comply with Title VIII, all~~
23 ~~funds intended for the purpose of providing service contracts to senators will be transferred to~~
24 ~~Index 402061, line item 5 "Senate Programming."~~

25 5. Graduation Stoles are available to any graduating student who, for at least two full semesters
26 (including summer) of their time at UNF, served in Student Government prior to graduation.
27 This includes members of the three branches, the Executive Agencies, and the Office of
28 Elections. Budget directors for each index shall consult with their professional staff advisor
29 regarding distribution of graduation stoles, with the SG Director having final approval.

30 A. Graduation stoles will be paid for by the Executive Branch out of the 'Student Government
31 Superlatives and Composite' line item under Student Government General Expenses.



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32 B. Students involved in Osprey Life and Productions are not eligible for a graduation stole, unless
33 they were involved in Osprey Productions while it was still an Executive Agency of Student
34 Government. This would include any student who joined before FY 19/20.

37 Therefore: Let it be enacted that the following changes made to Line 24 of the Proviso Language
38 from Budget FY 2020/2021 be made effective July 31, 2021.
