Whereas:

1 The Student Government of the University of North Florida was established to represent
2 student concerns in all University wide matters, and;

3 The Student Government of University of North Florida is dedicated to providing safe options
4 for students; and

5 From conversations with students, and the Osprey Voice survey on Campus Transportation,
6 students have expressed that they would utilize an escort program at the University of North
7 Florida; and;

Whereas:

8 The following is an addition to Title XI that incorporates SKYS (Students Keeping You Safe)
9 Program as an Executive Agency. As an Agency, this program will provide an escort service for
10 students when they want to be escorted to a different part of campus; and;

Therefore:

11 The following necessary and proper revisions to the Student Government System of Statutes are
12 being proposed in an effort to add the SKYS Program as an Executive Agency:

14 Chapter 1104: Students Keeping You Safe

15 1104.1 Creation and Purpose

- 16 A. Creation: This Statute shall create an Agency of Student Government known as
- 17 Students Keeping You Safe, also known as SKYS.
- 18 B. Purpose: The SKYS Agency is dedicated towards promoting safety at the
- 19 University of North Florida. This Agency is run by students who want to
- 20 ensure that each student at the University of North Florida feels safe and
- 21 comfortable on campus. SKYS offers rides and walking teams to escort
- 22 students to different parts of campus throughout the night.

23 1104.2 Internal Organization and Structure

- 24 A. The design of SKYS shall be:
 - 25 1. Director
 - 26 2. Assistant Director
 - 27 3. Staff Members
- 28 B. All members of SKYS will fulfill the roles of dispatching and escorting students
29 on campus.

30 1104.3 Powers and Duties of the SKYS Director

- 31 A. Organize training for the staff
 - 32 a. Training shall occur at the beginning of each semester.
 - 33 b. Training will be laid out in the Policies and Procedures.
- 34 B. Oversee the SKYS Program operations and staff.
- 35 C. Create and update the schedule.
- 36 D. Keep record of all financial transactions the Agency is responsible for.



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- 37 E. Have regular meetings with the Student Body Vice President, Accounting
- 38 Associate, and SKYS Staff.
- 39 F. Submit a weekly report to the Student Body Vice President.
- 40 G. Report to the Senate once a month.
- 41 H. Follow all duties as outlined in the Policies and Procedures.
- 42 1104.4 Powers and Duties of the SKYS Assistant Director
- 43 A. Regularly update the social media and inform students on the status and
- 44 operations of SKYS.
- 45 B. Plan tabling events to market the program.
- 46 C. Aiding the Director in any task they may need assistance in.
- 47 D. Fill in for the Director as needed.
- 48 E. Maintain copies of base logs, cart sheets, incident reports, and other forms.
- 49 F. Follow all duties as outlined in the Policies and Procedures.
- 50 1104.5 Duties of the SKYS Pilots
- 51 A. Follow instructions given by the Director and Assistant Director.
- 52 B. Follow all duties as outlined in the Policies and Procedures.
- 53 1104.6 Standing Committees
- 54 A. The SKYS Agency shall have the right to establish standing committees as its
- 55 leadership deems necessary.
