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SB-20F-3532: Provisionary Language Revisions

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2 Whereas: The Student Government of the University of North Florida was established to represent student
3 concerns in all University wide matters, and;

4 Whereas: The Budget & Allocations Committee is a standing committee of the Student Government Senate,
5 responsible for funding only those entities that comply with the Student Government mission,
6 which is to represent student concerns in all university wide matters while developing and
7 promoting programs and activities of practical value and interest to students, and;

8 Whereas: The following necessary and proper revisions to the Student Government System of Statutes are
9 being proposed in an effort to ensure future compliance with the law and the balance of our
10 democratic system:

Activity and Service Fee Budget Rider

1. Travel Related Expenses
Fiscal Year 2020/2021

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2. Travel related costs shall only be expended from the following indexes: 402060 Executive, 402062 SG Business and Administration, 402017 Osprey Productions, 402015 Lend-a-Wing Pantry, 402040 Student Involvement Center, 402028 Student Travel, and 402097 Special Requests, only through the Club Sports Travel Board. All other indexes are prohibited from expending A&S Fee funds for Travel.
3. Travel funds in the SG Executive budget are to be expended for Florida Student Association meetings, Florida Board of Governors meetings, and other lawful purposes as authorized by the Student Body President.
4. Travel funds in the SG Business and Administration Index are to be expended for the development of A&S funded A&P and USPS staff that directly support Student Government.
5. Travel funds in the Osprey Productions index and the Student Involvement Center index are to be expended for the purpose of attending workshops, conferences, and other events that enhance and develop their ability to carry out its assigned functions.
6. Travel funds awarded to the Lend-a-Wing Pantry index are to be expended for the purpose of obtaining food and other supplies for the pantry's use.
7. All funds allocated to the Student Travel Index 402028 during the budget process shall be equally divided between two subsidiary line-items: Fall Travel and Spring Travel.

SB-20F-3532: Provisionary Language Revisions

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A. Funds in the Fall Travel line may be used for travel when the departure date occurs on or between July 1st and December 31st.

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B. Funds in the Spring Travel line may be used for travel when the departure date occurs on or between January 1st and June 30th.

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8. Up to \$10,000 may be transferred into the Student Travel Index 402028 from the Special Request Index 402097 following the completion of a Centralized Budget Transfer Form, of which no more than \$5,000 may be transferred into the Fall line.

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9. Travel funds coming out of the Special Requests index 402097 must be authorized by the Clubs Sports Travel Board and in accordance Title VIII.

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Activity and Service Fee Budget Rider

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Club Funding Index

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Fiscal Year 2020/2021

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1. The Club Funding Index is intended to fulfill the purpose of the Activity and Service Fee by supporting special events and equipment purchases that promote campus life and enhance the mission of the University.

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2. Funds from this index shall only be awarded to those Registered Student Organizations (RSOs) having satisfied the requirements of Titles VIII and XI, as well as the policies and procedures established by the Student Involvement Center.

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3. Funds requested for t-shirts shall not exceed \$7 per item, or \$15 per item in the case of polo shirts or other specialty apparel.

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4. Those RSOs that register with the Student Involvement Center on or before the fall registration deadline, and are funding eligible, may receive a 'Registration grant' of no more than \$100.

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A. Registration grants shall only be awarded to those RSOs that were active in the preceding fiscal year and had attained the status of 'good standing' by the end of the spring semester.

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B. Eligible RSOs must submit a Registration Grant request form, signed by the RSO's President and Treasurer, in order to receive said grant. Therein, the organization must acknowledge the receipt of funds and that they must abide by all SG policies pertaining to the use of the A&S Fee.

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- 2 5. No RSO, without written permission from the SG Business Office and the SG
- 3 Treasurer, shall request more than \$15 per person on food.
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- 5 6. All funds allocated to the Club Funding Index 402041 during the budget process
- 6 shall be equally divided between two subsidiary line-items: Summer B/Fall Club
- 7 Funding and Spring/Summer A Club Funding.
- 8 A. Funds in the Summer B/Fall Club Funding line may be used when the
- 9 event or operation date occurs on or between July 1st and December 31st.
- 10 B. Funds in the Spring/Summer A Club Funding line may be used when the
- 11 event or operation date occurs on or between January 1st and June 30th.
- 12 C. Unused funds from the Registration Grants line after December 31st shall
- 13 be transferred into the Spring/Summer A Club Funding line.
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- 15 7. The Club Funding Board reserves the right to set specific expiration dates for
- 16 allocated funding at its discretion, in accordance with Title VIII.
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- 18 **Therefore:** Let it be enacted, by the University of North Florida Student Government, which the
- 19 following changes to Provisionary Language be made effective immediately .
